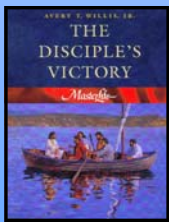

# Discipleship News...

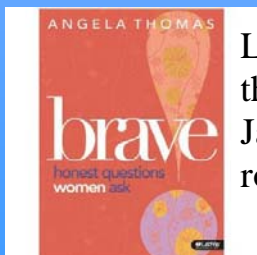

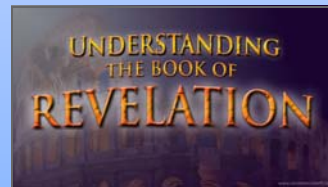
## F.A.I.T.H.

Evangelism has resumed and we are all excited about what the Lord will do through each of us as we go into



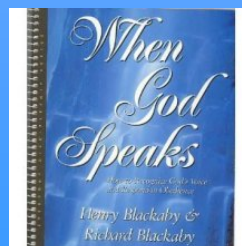

As we transition to a monthly newsletter, I want to inform you about the way I will be adjusting my communication. I will also rely more on announcements during normal youth meetings so be sure to be present and on time. Here is a snapshot of the next couple of months:

**Camp** will be July 29-August 3 and will be back at Camp Cherokee! God has worked in so many students and parents lives there and I'm looking forward to another great year with the Chad Lister Band coming back to lead worship. This is a trip that the [rising 6th graders can attend](#) so be sure to save the date and see me for some info if you have a rising 6th grader. (We will have a formal meeting for all rising 6th graders and parents in May). I need lots of adult volunteers for camp, especially men. It takes an army to pull off camp as I need everything from boat drivers, to cook staff, to counselors, to referees, to prayer partners and just about everything in between.
